

Creative Warehouse CW Knitting Pattern



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Modified Brioche Scarf



Needle size: 10.5

Gauge: 5 stitches/1 inch over pattern

(Optional) Crochet hook size G or H.

Yarn: About 500 - 550 yards worsted weight yarn.

This sample uses 2nd Time Cotton from Knit One Crochet Too.

(Optional): 1 ball of contrasting yarn for trim.

Modified brioche stitch

Multiple of 2 plus 1.

Base row: Slip 1 (edge stitch), * Yarn over, slip 1 with yarn in front, K 1. Repeat from * to the end of the row.

Pattern row: Slip 1 (edge stitch), * Yarn over, slip 1 with yarn in front, K 2 together (slipped stitch plus yarn over from the previous row). Repeat from * to the end of the row.

Repeat pattern row.

Scarf.

Cast on 33 stitches. Work pattern until scarf reaches 60 inches or desired length. Bind off loosely. Add fringe if desired.

Edging (optional)

Use a large crochet hook (G or H) and contrasting yarn to do a row of single crochet in the slipped edge stitches along each long edge.

Keep the crocheted stitches loose to preserve the elasticity of the scarf.
